I wish to express our heartfelt thanks to you for your generous contribution to *The 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Joey O'Donnell Film Premiere*. Because of your generosity and dedication we are proud to announce that \$865,000 was raised for cystic fibrosis research and medical programs. Your support allows the Foundation to persevere in its drive to fund the best scientific minds; **adding tomorrows** to the lives of all people with cystic fibrosis.

As you know, January 31, 2012 marked an important milestone in our journey to find a cure for cystic fibrosis with the FDA approval of Kalydeco (previously known as VX-770) – the first drug to address the underlying cause of cystic fibrosis. Recent results from a Phase 2 study of Kalydeco combined with another potential drug, VX-809, showed promise in people with two copies of the most common CF gene mutation, and further combination trials are planned with leading pharmaceutical companies. These results are cause for great optimism.

We still have a great deal of work ahead of us but because of your support of the Joey Fund and Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, many of the people with CF now have the access to a drug that drastically improves their quality of life – we thank you.
